☞ Baku is the capital city of Azerbaijan.

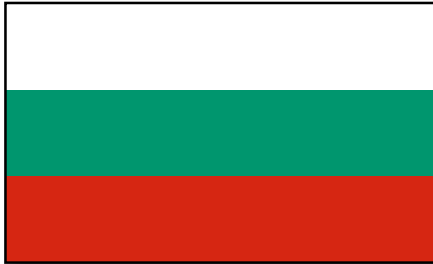
☞ The **Azerbaijani** flag is blue, red, green and white.

EGYPT / EGYPTIAN



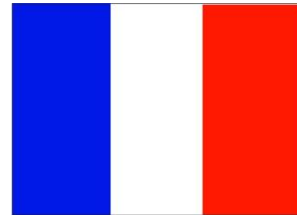
- ☞ The Pyramids are in **Egypt**.

IRAQ / IRAQI



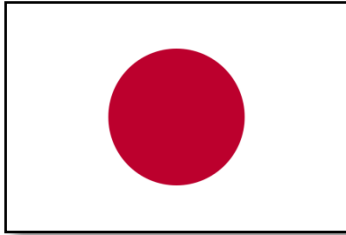
- ☞ **Iraq** is the neighboring country of Turkey.

SPAIN / SPANISH



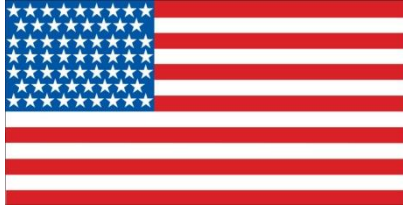
- ☞ You can see a bull-fighting in **Spain**.

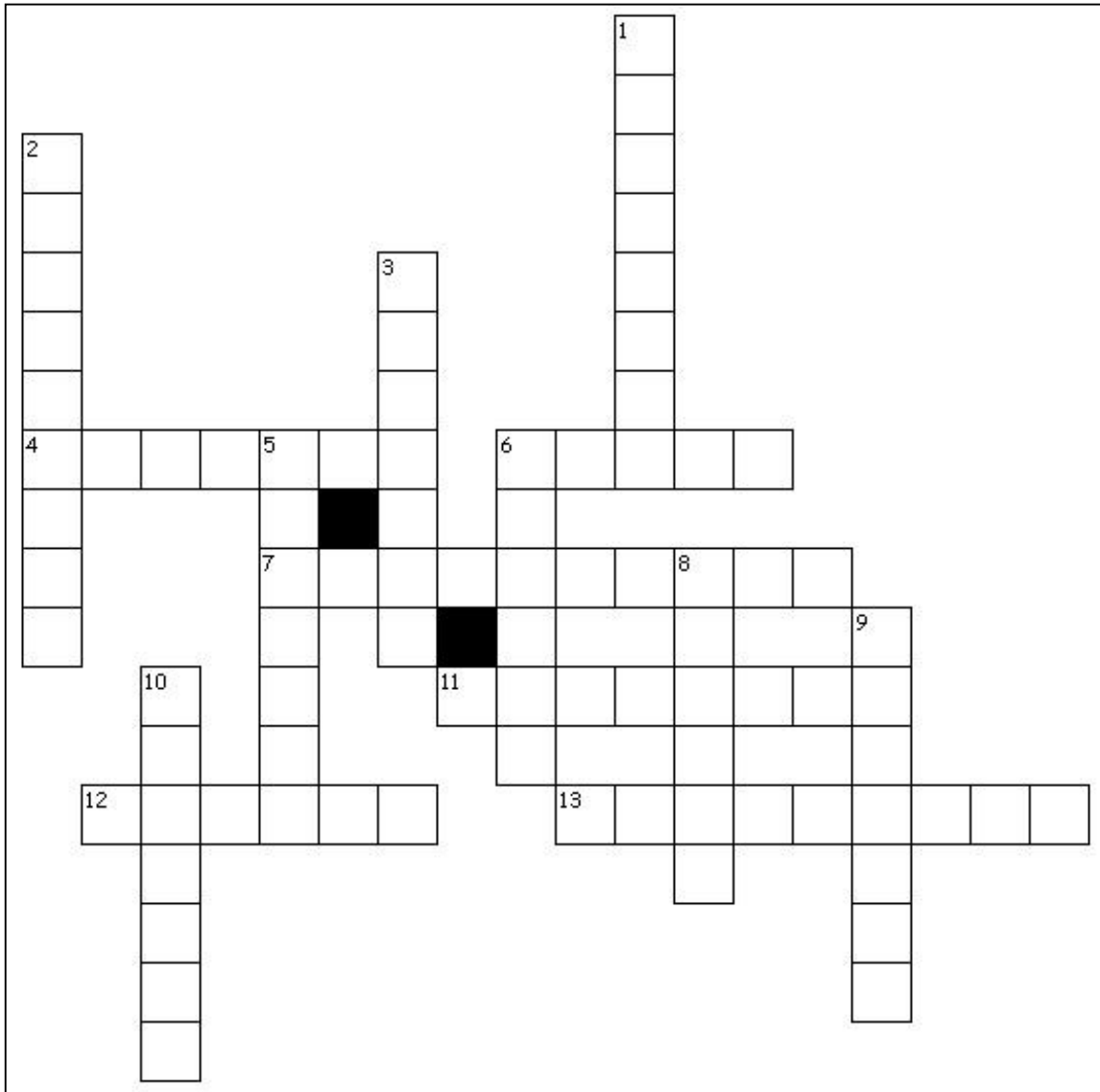

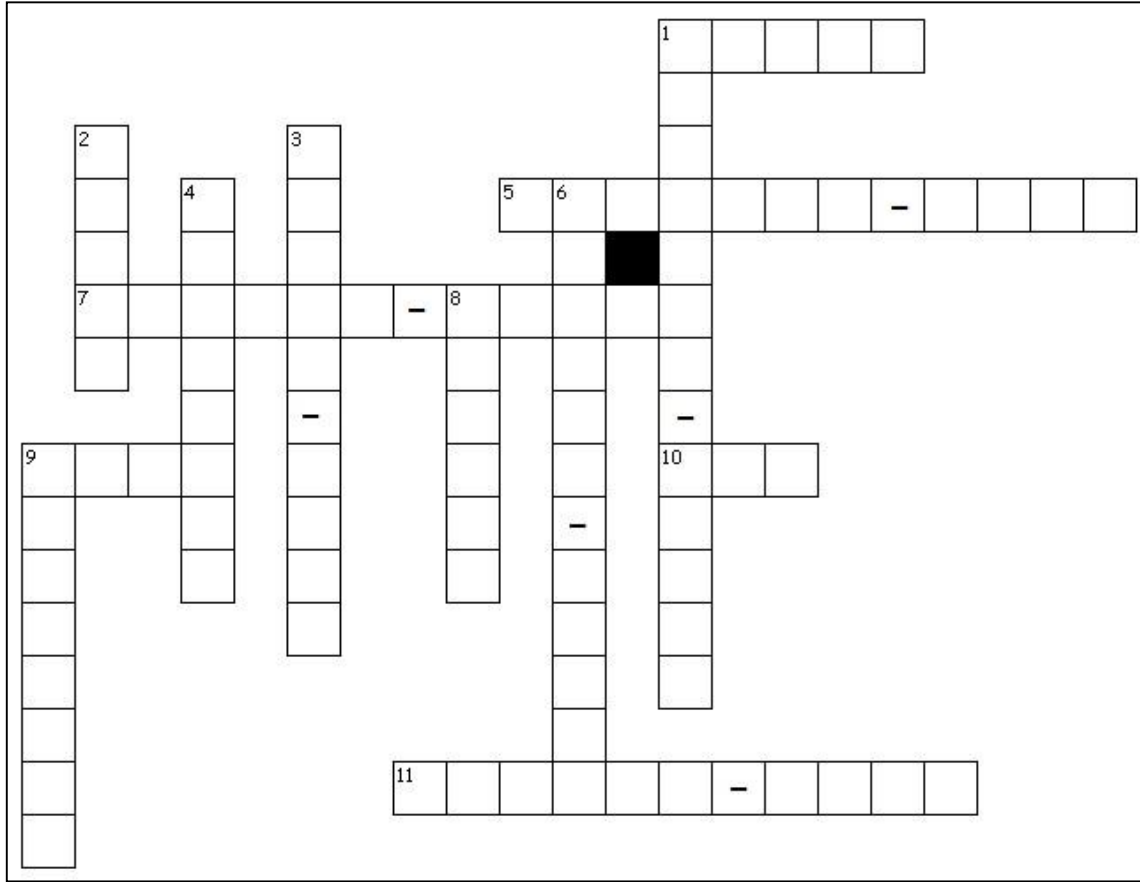
